About Me

Based on a farm in the North East of Scotland, I have been making tweed products for the last 4 years, what initially started as just a hobby and a way of making personal gifts for friends has now grown to a slightly bigger enterprise and I sell via local craft fairs. I have ventured as far south as Edinburgh and Perth and even sold some things at my friends wedding in Gloucestershire. My products have been sent all around the world by my customers who want to give something that is uniquely Scottish but equally modern to their friends and family

The Fabric

All the fabrics used in my products are designed and woven in the North East of Scotland. The cloth is manufactured using yarns which have been spun locally. The colours, which reflect the diversity of the Scottish landscape, are used together to create modern products and give a new look to traditional tweed fabric. Tweed or woollen fabric is often perceived as coarse and harsh this is not the case. The cloths I use are all made from wool 'grown' in the southern hemisphere which gives the fabric its soft touch.

The Concept

All the items I make are unique, made up of different co-ordinating fabrics which would otherwise have been thrown away, combined with silk, corduroy and velvet for a luxurious feel. My products make ideal gifts or can be bought to brighten up your own home. I also offer a bespoke service and can make cushions, bags or any other item in a specific colour palette.
